Luke Champion is the United Kingdom's lead on cyber, digital, and tech processes at the United Kingdom Permanent Mission to the United Nations in New York. He recently negotiated the formation of the Global Mechanism on ICT and the modalities of the UN's Scientific Panel and Global Dialogue on AI Governance. Previously, Champion undertook a sabbatical to work with Microsoft's UN and International Organizations team, tracking international AI governance efforts. Prior to arriving in New York, he led the UK Foreign Office's first cyber defense program, supporting Ukraine's defense.
